About the British Chamber of Commerce in Germany e.V. (BCCG)

With 900 members, BCCG is the largest British-German economic network organisation in Europe, established in 1919. BCCG's aims include strengthening British-German economic relations and promoting Germany and the United Kingdom as investment locations. With ten honorary regional committees, BCCG organizes many events throughout the year.

About the International Club Berlin e.V.

The history of the International Club Berlin reaches back to the late 19th century. It was the Berlin Ice-Skating Club, founded in 1893. For many years the recreational location was a mainstay in Berlin's social life.

In June 1945 the grounds and buildings became the home of the British Officer's Club. After the withdrawal of the British protecting forces from reunified Berlin, 35 Berlin citizens founded the International Club Berlin e.V. in 1994. The British heir to the throne, His Royal Highness Prince Charles, is patron of the International Club Berlin just as he was during the era of the British Officers' Club.
