

In cooperation with the British Chamber of Commerce Germany (BCCG), Goethe Business School offers scholarships to highly-talented and ambitious applicants who wish to study in the **Goethe Executive MBA in Alliance with Duke**, the **Goethe Full-Time MBA** or the **Executive Master of Finance and Accounting** program. The scholarship granted may cover up to a maximum of 50% of the tuition fee.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships are granted based on demonstrated financial need, as well as academic and professional achievements. The amount granted varies depending on the applicant's profile. Applicants who receive financial support from their company may not qualify.

To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must have:

- A letter of recommendation from BCCG
- A letter from your employer confirming that you do not receive any financial funding for the program
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent with a strong grade point average
- Minimum of two years' (MBA) or minimum of four years' (EMBA) post-university work experience
- A recommended Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) score of 600 or higher (if applicable)

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must first apply to and qualify for the program. Applications may be submitted online at www.goethe-business-school.de.

A complete application includes:

- Completed online application form
- Current resume in English
- 2 online recommendations (in English or German)
- Two essays in English
- Official score of the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) (if applicable)
- Official score of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). (Minimum score of 95, waivers possible)
- Official university transcripts in English or German
- A non-refundable application fee of €130

Tuition includes all university fees, lodging and lunches during international residencies, as well as public transportation in Frankfurt. Goethe EMBA students also receive lunches and snacks while in Frankfurt. It does not include any travel expenses, computer hardware or accommodation in Frankfurt.

START & APPLICATION DEADLINES

Programs begin each year in September.

Application deadlines are:

- January 18, 2010 - 10% tuition discount
- April 19, 2010 - 5% tuition discount
- June 1, 2010

Tuition discounts are granted to admitted applicants who submit a completed application including required supporting documents by the respective deadline.
